

PUBLIC PETITION DEMANDING CESSATION OF THE CONCESSION CONTRACT OF JAKARTA WATER SUPPLY SERVICES

The message for Mr. Fauzi Bowo as Governor of Jakarta to take decisive action in protecting the rights to water of Jakarta's citizens by stopping the concession contract of water service in Jakarta.

Water concessions in Jakarta

Since 13 years ago, Jakarta water services has shifted from PAM Jaya to the two private operators; PT. PAM Lyonnaise Jaya (PT Palyja) and PT. Aetra (formerly owned by PT. Thames PAM Jaya). Privatization of water services is done through a 25 years concession contract. Concession area of each private operator is to divide the Ciliwung River where the west part of Ciliwung became the concession area for PT.Palyja, while eastern Ciliwung River became the concession area of PT. Aetra. Privatization of water services in Jakarta conducted by PAM Jaya-which was considered not to have technical and financial capabilities needed to improve water service in the national capital. While the two private operators are believed to have the technical expertise and funds to make clean water service in Jakarta equivalent to other capitals in various developed countries.

The contracts originated as political acts of the Suharto regime. The process started with a letter from President Suharto in 1995, and ended with two companies being appointed in 1997, without any competitive tendering. The corruption in this process was visible in the original share allocations: the British firm Thames Water allocated shares to a firm owned by the son of the president, the French company Suez Lyonnaise des Eaux allocated shares to a firm owned by a crony of Suharto. After the fall of Suharto in 1998, these allocations were rapidly reduced.

The companies are paid according to their costs, protected against inflation, interest rates, foreign exchange rate and even tax changes (FTY p.94). These include a 'know-how' fee, or management fee, which is typical of water concessions; a World Bank paper noted that the effect of these 'management fees' is to provide a guaranteed dividend for the owners of the operating companies. In addition, the charge is calculated to provide a guaranteed return on capital of 22% (CA clause 27.1, schedule 6: CR p.13, FTY pp. 54-66). The tariffs paid by customers are effectively determined by these charges, so that if these tariffs are held down to make them affordable, the deficit has to be covered by the public authorities, not by the operators.

Jakarta Water Concession, an Exhibition Failure of Water Privatization Policy

The two private operators failed to meet the technical targets set out in the contract. By now, there is still a bigger percentage of Jakartan who has not had access to clean water, and even some residents of Jakarta who has been a customer since 1997-PAM JAYA have to wait at least for 7 years to get clean water supply.

The overall objectives of the contract still refer to 'comprehensive coverage...substantial extension....increase efficiency.... Ensure the quantity, quality and continuity of supply of clean water and potable water... to meet the technical target and service standards.... to reduce the quantity of

unaccounted for water.....' (CA2001 art 2.2; CR pp6-7). But the actual performance of the companies is very poor. There has been little extension of the network, with the lowest level of coverage of major Asian cities; the price per cubic meter of water is the highest of any major Asian city; in terms of quality, the water coming out of the taps must be boiled; in terms of efficiency, non-revenue water remains over 50% (FTY pp. 5, 105-137).

Service coverage based on the latest operators' claims is 63% at the end of 2008; this means there are 37% of Jakarta's residents have not received drinking water facilities. Even the Central Bureau of Statistics (BPS) says that the Piped water service in Jakarta touched only 24.18% of the population. Which means more than 75% of the city dwellers not getting adequate services through the piped water? A recent report, the number of customers PT. PALYJA as many as 409,000, while the PT. Aetra (d / h TPJ), including 377,072 customers, if one connection is used by 4-5 people (assuming the BPS, 1 KK = 4-5 people) then the residents of Jakarta who has access to clean water is only about 3,930,360 inhabitants. As a result, most poor people in Jakarta have to buy water from vendors around them with a very expensive price.

Ironically, when these two private operators managed to escape the consequences from failing to meet various technical and service targets, but the company always managed to obtain and even continue to increase earnings from year to year. Palyja, in 2006 managed to increase net profit by 32.8% and rise up to 52.5% the following year. In 2008 and still they managed to increase profits equal to 15.85%. To be able to always record a profit, the prevailing water tariff in Jakarta should always set high and has a big difference compared to the cost of production is needed. This means that company profits obtained from the customer tariff payments whose value far exceeds the cost of production to drain water to the customer.

The concession contract of Jakarta's water services is designed to fully protect the interests of private and not public. In other cities, termination of a water concession contract can be done even without having to pay any penalty. This is already happening in Bamako - Mali, Da Chang - China and Buenos Aires – Argentina, and there's a widespread public demand to a Remunicipalitation of their water service accross Europe.

Water privatization remains unpopular policy today, mainly because of price increases required by private operators. In addition, private operators also did not make any investment that is expected to expand and improve networks, does not make the expected efficiency improvements. Furthermore, the concession contract given to the private-foreign companies is created from an authoritarian system (without public consultation process) does not create a sufficient incentive to overcome the water problems in Jakarta, evidence to date PAM Jaya as a management of public services continues to lose money, many households are unable to access water service due to private operator's reluctance to invest their funds for infrastructure development.

Of the 400 major world cities (with populations of more than one million) only 14% of its water services are managed by private companies, the rest is managed by a public company, even Paris has just restore water service to the public sector. In some countries - Uruguay and the Netherlands - the privatization of water services is illegal.

Our Demands

Due to water privatization in Jakarta for 13 years jeopardize the government of DKI Jakarta and also has caused the neglect of the right of the people on the water in Jakarta, we demand the Governor of Jakarta to:

1. Stop water service concession contract in Jakarta, with two private operators (PT. Palyja and PT. Aetra).

2. Plan any necessary measures that can encourage PAM Jaya to be a good and reliable public water service provider, without having to involve the private sector.
